3RD ANNUAL MT. CARMEL CONVOCATION

The convocation will include in-depth teaching on the prophetic significance of Israel, the Church, and Islam. There will also be an emphasis on intercessory worship sessions, as we join together as the "one new man" of Jews, Arabs, and Gentiles from the nations, being built together as a "dwelling place for God in the Spirit" (Ephesians 2:22).

We believe this will be a strategic time for us to stand in unity, proclaiming the decrees of the Lord, that as we "shout from the top of the mountains...give glory to the Lord... He shall prevail against His enemies" (Isaiah 42:11-13).

Please pray about participating in this gathering and consider bringing a group from your congregation. A five-day biblical tour will also be available following the convocation.

CONVOCATION ACCOMMODATION: US\$520 per person (double occupancy) includes: 5 nights from Tuesday, May 4 until Sunday, May 9 half-board (breakfast and dinner) accommodation at the Dan Panorama Hotel in the center of Haifa. Transportation to and from the hotel to the Kehilat HaCarmel worship center.

NOT INCLUDED: Airfare to and from Israel, transfer to and from airport, medical insurance and personal expenses.

REGISTRATION: Apply to: convocation@carmel-assembly.org.il for a registration form for information about a group coordinator in your area.

CANCELLATION: All cancellations prior to April 1 will be refunded except for US\$75 non-refundable fee. Cancellation on or after April 1 will be subject to a cancellation fee of US\$200 per person. If you need to cancel and are sharing a room, you will be responsible to cover the cost of the single supplement.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT: Add US\$337 if you require a single room. The number of single rooms is limited.

CONVOCATION REGISTRATION FEE:

US\$100 (or equivalent in €) includes lunches and tips during the Convocation. US\$10 (or equivalent in €) for translation headset if required. These fees must be paid in cash upon arrival at convocation.

PAYMENTS:

1. Deposit of US\$150 by March 2, 2010 (\$75 non-refundable).
2. Final payment US\$370 by April 1, 2010 (\$200 non-refundable after this date).
3. US\$100 (or equivalent in €) in cash at registration upon arrival.
4. US\$10 (or equivalent in €) in cash at registration upon arrival for translation headset if required.

All information on where payment should be sent will be given you upon written request.

SCHEDULE :

1. Check-in on the afternoon of Tuesday, May 4, followed by dinner.
2. Teaching and intercessory worship sessions on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. All day from Wednesday till Thursday night. Friday sessions end mid- afternoon followed by a traditional Shabbat evening dinner.
3. Thursday night: Intercessory worship evening led by Karen Davis.
4. Saturday: Join the Shabbat service with our local congregation. Enjoy a Druze lunch in the village, visit Muqraka overlooking the Valley of Armageddon with on-site teaching. In the evening, prayer over the city of Haifa from the Louis Promenade behind the hotel.
5. Sunday, May 9: the Convocation package ends after breakfast.

DISCLAIMER:

Should the government of Israel implement Value Added Tax of 16.5% on tourist services before the Convocation and Tour, we will pass this expense onto all participants and increase the costs accordingly.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE:

Under pastoral leadership of Peter Tsukahira and David Davis, who will be teaching on-site along with experienced believing tour guides:

Sunday, May 9: Tour of the Galilee including Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee

Monday, May 10: Tour of ancient Caesarea, a teaching session in the Roman Amphitheater; go up to Jerusalem; have lunch near Jerusalem; visit Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial

Tuesday, May 11: Teaching on the Mt. of Olives; prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane, the Western Wall; teaching on the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount

Wednesday, May 12: Visit Masada, Herod's desert fortress; Qumran, the caves of the Dead Sea Scrolls; have lunch at Qumran, and swim in the Dead Sea

Thursday, May 13: Visit Temple Mount; Bethesda Pool at St. Anne's Church, Old City; Garden Tomb

Friday, May 14: Check-out and depart for Ben Gurion International Airport

THIS YEAR IN JERUSALEM!

TOUR COST AND PAYMENT:

US\$660 per person (double occupancy) which includes:

- 5 nights half-board accommodation (breakfast and dinner) in the Dan Panorama Hotel in Haifa (1 night) and Olive Tree Hotel in Jerusalem (4 nights)
- 3 lunches include ones at the Sea of Galilee, in Jerusalem and at the Dead Sea
- 5 full days touring with our own pastoral staff and believing guides

PAYMENTS:

1. Deposit for the Convocation is sufficient for the Tour.
2. Final payment by April 1, 2010.
3. Additional US\$50 (or equivalent in €) in cash at registration upon arrival for tips.
4. Additional US\$10 (or equivalent in €) in cash at registration upon arrival for translation headset if required.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT:

Add US\$373 if you require a single room. The number of single rooms is limited.

NOT INCLUDED:

Lunches on 2 days when touring within the Old City of Jerusalem.

Medical insurance and personal expenses.

Transfer to and from the airport.
